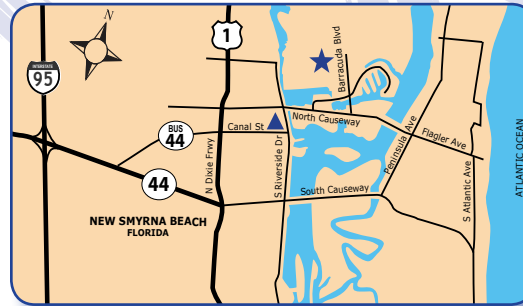

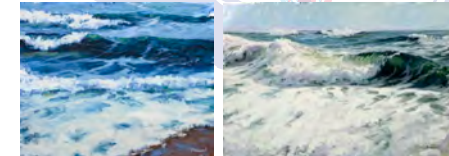

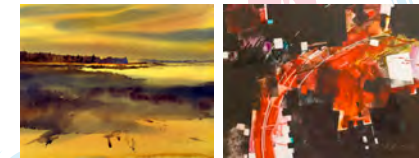

PAT WEAVER

“Spontaneous Watercolor or Acrylic with Pat Weaver”



Pat Weaver is an accomplished artist whose work consistently receives high praise whether teaching painting workshops or completing fine art commissions. Pat is a past president and Signature Member of the Florida Watercolor Society.

Pat will explore and excite color with limited palettes. She will teach you:

- How to paint with 2 - no more than 5 - colors in any one painting
- How to mix beautiful grays to enhance your paintings
- A simplified approach to drawing, using a template for design and composition
- The importance of understanding the use of analogous color
- How to establish the temperature of a painting before painting the subject

Pat has an impressionist approach to painting, teaching direct painting (alla prima) with drawing - the use of titanium white casein mixed with transparent watercolor in painting animals. Please bring plenty of photo reference material. Any subject may be painted in this workshop, such as landscapes, florals, animals, people, etc.

Sue St. John is a Signature Member of the American Watercolor Society and the Kentucky Watercolor Society. She is the recipient of many awards and resides in Indiana.

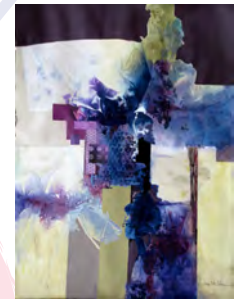
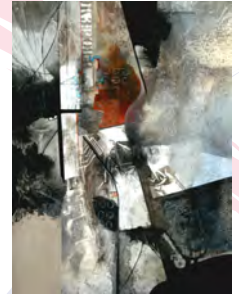
