Members Show Winners in Studio Library

Since our Member's Show was held outside of New Smyrna Beach last year, we thought it would be nice to hang the winners from the show on our Artists' Workshop library wall. If you won a prize in the Member's show, bring your artwork to the studio by August 31 and leave it against the wall in the matting and framing room.

Delivery: by Friday, August 31.

Pick Up: Friday, September 28

We are still sort of "floating" with scheduling the remainder of this coming gallery season. We are planning to have our Canal Street Gallery back open again for the October show (Oct. 8 - Columbus Day), with the entry date for works on October 5th. The show's theme will be "**MARITIME MADNESS**", which can include the sea, anything on, in, near or living near the sea; nautical (boats, etc.), applicable people and abstract to fit the theme. (More about this in next month's newsletter.)

The monthly themes for the remaining shows may still move around, but here is the tentative list to date:

NOVEMBER: "ROULETTE: ROUGE et NOIR"

Works with prominent accents of reds and/or blacks (darks). Any subject.

DECEMBER: "SPECTRUM III" (Judged)

Subject your choice.

JANUARY: "GETTING AROUND"

Landscape/travel anywhere: Mountains, desert, wetlands, farms, etc.; roads/old cars, other transportation; architecture/buildings/cityscape anywhere; people in those places; abstract.

FEBRUARY: "MEMBERS EXHIBIT"

MARCH: "VERGING ON VAN GOGH"

BOLD, STRONG COLORS for objects, interiors, people, landscape, etc. A go for impressionistic and abstract works.

APRIL: "SPECTRUM IV" (Judged)

Subject your choice.

MAY: "THE ARK ASSORTMENT"

Works containing, somewhere in them, animals and/or people.

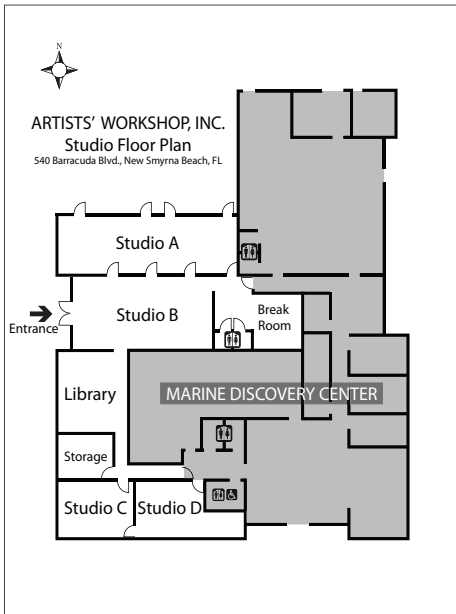
