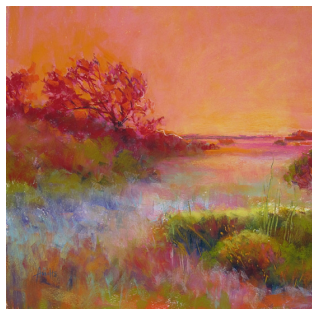

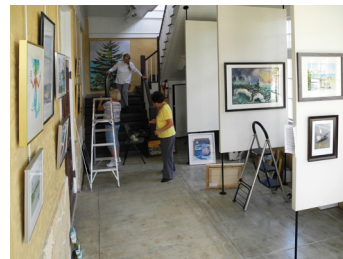
Canal Street Gallery Reopens!
