t the end of this month a fresh Winter/Summer schedule will come out. Please keep a sharp eye opened as there are new exciting Guest Artist Sessions as well as our regular team of teachers. To give you a "sneek peek", I can let you know that Christophe Cardot will add a **Painting** class on Monday afternoons. He will still maintain his Thursday morning class, but is expanding. He has room for students in both time slots. The Mixed Media class will be taking a short hiatus so please keep in touch if that is your interest.

We have an exciting group of Guest Artists:

Michelle Davidson will be teaching another **Fused Glass** class on January 25, from 9:30 A.M. to 12:30 P.M. It is \$55 to make 3 pieces with supplies provided. This is a one day class that will teach you the basics of creating fused glass jewelry. The only tool to bring is your creativity. If you are interested, email her at fusedmd@yahoo.com.

Lisa Brooks will offer two 4-week classes in **Photoshop**, and **Web Design**, beginning the middle of February. Classes will be held Tuesday afternoons, 1 - 4:00 P.M. and cost \$100 for each 4-week session, with a \$25 deposit to hold your place. The first offering is "Photoshop." You'll learn about the elements of good photographic composition, resizing images, tools for tweaking photos, and the use of layers & filters. The second 4-week class (mid-Mar into Apr) will be "Web Design for the Artist," using FREE web production templates and tools. This class is for beginners thru intermediates, and by the end of the first class students will have a published web page. There is a limit of 8 participants per class. 
