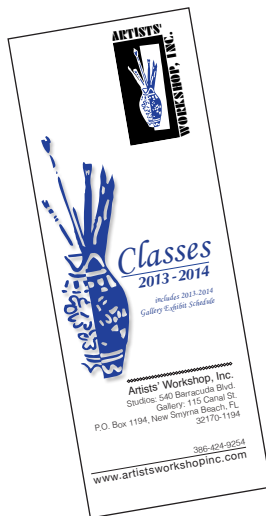

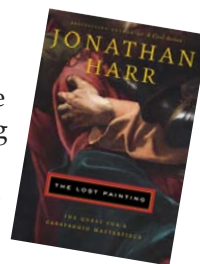
I am putting a box out on the desk for donations to the library to purchase needed books and library materials. I will have books out for sale on the library desk and also at our monthly meetings.

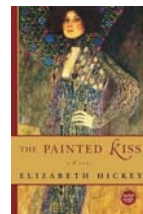
