*****SOME THEMES IN PROGRESS FOR NEXT SEASON******

NOVEMBER: "CHAIRS SQUARED" (Theme)

e.g. Chair(s) alone, like a portrait - may be abstracted, colorful; bench in park. beach chair, lifeguard perch, swings, natural seating places (ledge, rock), figure or pet on a chair, rides at a fair, etc. May be a small part of a larger work interior or landscape. Think creatively about CHAIRS and how your art can be part of this potentially "way out" exhibit. (Read title as lots of chairs, not square chairs.)

A "small" show for our JUDGED EXHIBIT 20 X 20" maximum.

"BLACK, WHITE, AND ART ALL OVER" (Theme)

Show emphasis is on black and white works (could be charcoal, pencil, photo, paint), but also will include colored works. Any subject or abstract.

"PERSPECTIVE AND THE HUMAN IMAGE" (Theme)

Perspective: What or where is the artist's point of view in the work? Joins with portraiture and people. Abstract works for both.


