The emphasis of this show is to significantly deepen the shadowed "dark side" of your chosen subject, and accent the brightest light. Could be structures with deeply shadowed sides, still life objects, or people given strong lighting with deep shadows (think Rembrandt). Check with your teachers if you want to know how to handle this chiaroscuro look with your medium, or contact a Gallery Chair for information.
