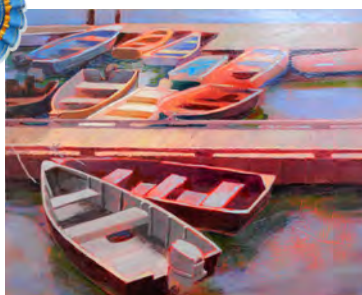

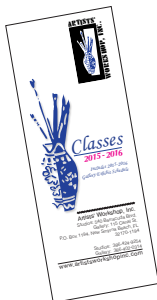

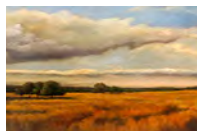
Classes Update

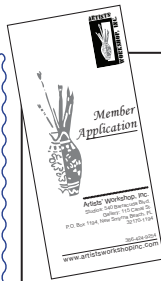

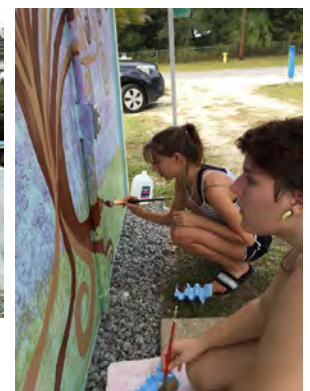
