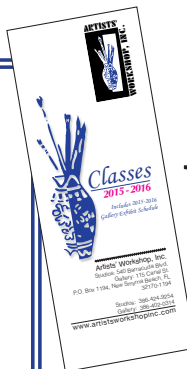
NO MEMBER MEETING: Wed., March 2, 2016

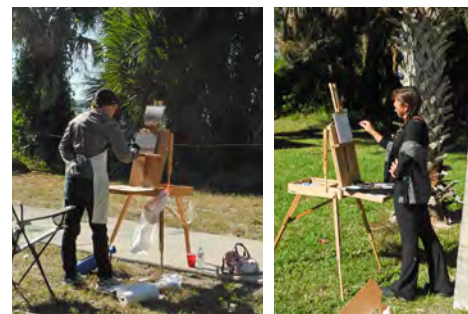
