he Artists' Workshop sponsored its 18th Annual New Smyrna Beach High School Visual Arts Exhibit at the New Smyrna Beach Library this past May. The exhibit showcased 93 original works of art by students in grades 9-12, in various media including photography; sculpture/ceramics; and drawing, painting, mixed media and collage. The student art was on display for public viewing at the NSB Library throughout the month of May.

New Smyrna Beach Mayor James Hathaway presented the awards to the students, emphasizing how strongly the arts are woven into the fabric of the community. AWI member Cathy Berse served as Juror of the exhibit. 



