The student art was on display for public viewing at the NSB Library throughout the month of May.

New Smyrna Beach Mayor James Hathaway presented the awards to the students, emphasizing how strongly the arts are woven into the fabric of the community. AWI member Cathy Berse served as Juror of the exhibit. 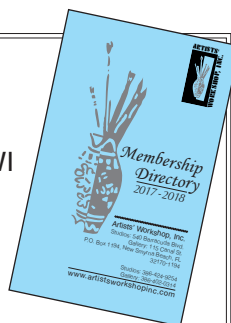

It includes a listing of all current members as of the June 30th cutoff date.

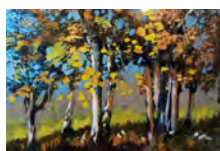




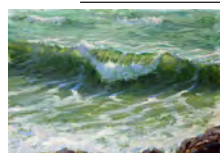

I have been thinking all summer about new books and what everyone seems to enjoy. Soooooo...

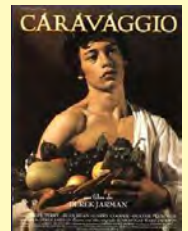
