November 1st Meeting: James Murphy Ph.D.

"Reflections on Art and Popular Culture"

Our November 1, 2017 Members' Meeting will feature Dr. James Murphy. Dr. Murphy was the first program director at Atlantic Center for the Arts, as well as holding full-time faculty positions at the University of Alabama, Stetson University, and Florida State University, where he served as chairman of the Department of Art. He will be doing a lecture/discussion called "Reflections on Art and Popular Culture". This will encompass works of art both high and low, from a variety of media, and will address such questions as: Why was Conan Doyle unable to kill off his famous detective? Why do we love Whistler's mother? Why did Norman Rockwell paint a Jackson Pollock abstraction and why does Rockwell's work now command record prices, even more than Georgia O'Keeffe's? These and other intriguing issues will form the theme of his presentation. Please plan on joining us for what is bound to be a very lively and thought provoking evening!



Upcoming December Judged Gallery Exhibit

"Think Grand, Create Small" - JoAnn Reilly

The Artists' Workshop Gallery is honored to have Trish Thompson as our judge for our December exhibit "Think Grand, Create Small" judged exhibit of small art. Thompson has her bachelors and masters degrees in painting and design from Florida State University and spent a year studying painting in Florence, Italy as part of FSU overseas study program. Her Doctorate work is in museum studies. Thomson recently retired from her position as professor in the Cultural Arts Department at Daytona State College, where she taught painting, design, and art appreciation courses. Trish Thompson has been painting for over 40 years and focusing on acrylics for the last 30. Trish has exhibited her work in solo and group shows throughout Florida. Thompson's work is also held in many public and corporate collections in Orlando, Atlanta, London, Japan, and the President's Palace in Bogota, Colombia. Trish served as Curator of Education for the Museum of Arts and Science and the Southeast Museum of Photography in Daytona Beach, FL Thomson has also served as a judge for over 50 local, regional, national and international exhibitions and has participated as associate artist with four artists in residence at Atlantic Center for the Arts.

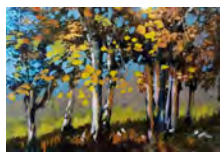
