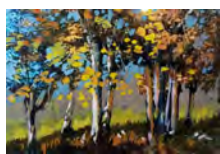

Robert J. Simone, nationally known award winning artist and Signature Member of the American Society of Marine Artists (ASMA), shares his expertise at painting coastal scenery.

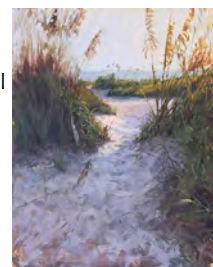

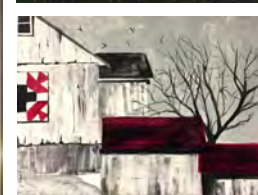
Community Exhibits
