
60th Annual Members' Show Update

January 28 Short-Term Class: PIT FIRING

Studio A & Out by the Fire Ring

Clay Studio is having a PIT FIRING all day on Sunday, January 28. This is another alternative firing method to explore and will substitute for the Raku Firing scheduled for that day. Under the direction of teacher Susie Means, we will build a pit and a wood fire around our pots out in back of the AWI Studios, just as Native Americans did. The heat of the fire will harden the clay and various additions such as borax, banana peels, glazes, copper wire, etc., will help color them. The class will also gather on Friday, January 26 from 1 to 4 PM to glaze pieces and to learn more about the process prior to the Sunday event.

Make your pots out of Raku type clay that can withstand the shock of fast rising irregular heat. Make them a bit thicker than usual and please don't make them larger than 9" x 9" x 9". You can bring up to 3 pieces. They need to be bisque fired when you come to the Friday Class Session. Visitors are welcome anytime Sunday, but we would love to have you come to the unveiling Sunday at 5 PM.

The class will be held in Studio A and outside in the field. \$50 Members, \$65 Non-Members for the 2-day session and a \$10 supply fee. We will need a minimum of 4 students to hold the class. Susie Means has a great deal of PIT FIRING experience and will make this a wonderful new experience for our Clay Studio. 
