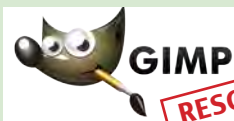

## Workshop News

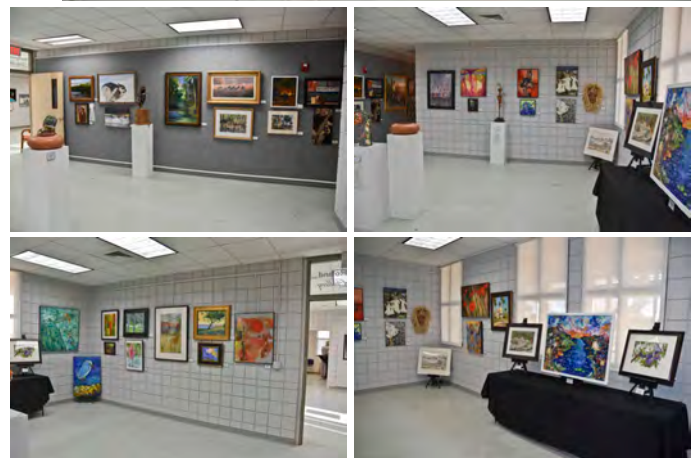

(Marilynne Roland was a dear, long-time devoted member and past president of the Artists' Workshop, who passed away in Jan. 2017 at the age of 94.)



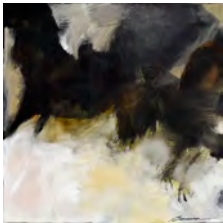

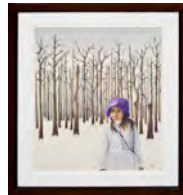

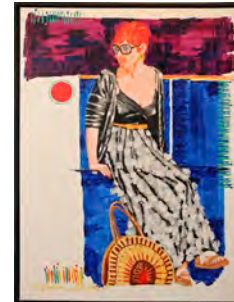

## Community Exhibits

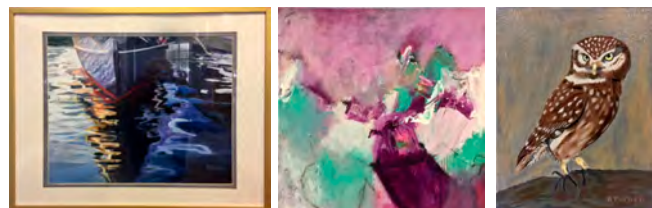
