2018 - 2019 Gallery on Canal Season:

(Members: Please refer to your 2018-2019 Members Directory for additional details and complete Rules about Gallery Exhibiting.)

SEPTEMBER 2018: "ARTISTS' CHOICE" (No Theme) Open: Sept. 1 - Oct. 4.

OCTOBER - DECEMBER 2018: "IN THE ABSTRACT" (Themed Show) This show will feature our abstract artists. Artists who would like to be "Featured Artists" for this show may rent a panel for a \$20 fee and show one large or up to 4 small paintings. The window panel and the top of the landing will each be a \$20 fee and will be considered "Featured Artists." These two spaces are meant to hold ONE LARGE PAINTING and will be assigned by the gallery chairman. The money generated will be used for additional advertising as well as glossy postcards that will be distributed throughout the community. "Featured Artists" will be included in the advertising along with a picture of one of their paintings. The rest of the gallery will hold single paintings and ceramics at \$5.00 each. ALL PAINTINGS MUST BE ABSTRACT. Due to closures for Columbus Day, Christmas, and New Year holidays, this show will remain in place longer than the other shows. Open: October 5 - December 21.

JANUARY - FEBRUARY 2019: "IN LOVE WITH LANDSCAPES" (Themed Show) This exhibit is meant to feature our landscape artists and will last two months. Any medium may be used. Landscapes can include buildings, people, and wildlife. BUT ALL PAINTINGS MUST BE LANDSCAPES. Refer to the fee schedule for the Oct. Nov. Dec. show if you wish to be a featured artist. Open: January 5 - February 28.

MARCH 2019: "ARTISTS' CHOICE" (No Theme) Open: March 2 - April 4.

APRIL - MAY 2019: "WONDERFUL WATERCOLOR" (Themed Show) This exhibit is meant to feature our water media artists.. All paintings must be done in water medium. Any subject matter. Refer to the fee schedule for the Oct. Nov. Dec. show if you wish to be a featured artist. Open: April 6 - May 30.

JUNE 2019: "ARTISTS' CHOICE" (No Theme) Open: June 1 - July 3.

JULY - AUGUST 2019: "SURF'S UP" (Themed Show) Anything to do with the ocean: birds, fish, shells, waves, driftwood, a day at the beach, fishing, surfing, swimming, boating, and so on. Let's get colorful! This show will be up for two months. No featured artists for this themed show. Open: July 6 - August 29.

2019 ARTISTS' WORKSHOP 61st ANNUAL MEMBERS' SHOW

**Opening January 19, 2019
Held at AWI Studios**

AWI DUES PAID: Member must be in good standing by Oct. 19, 2018 to be eligible to enter a work in the show.

- **ORIGINAL WORK:** Must be your own original work.
- **CURRENT WORK:** Work entered must be no more than 2 yrs. old, not previously exhibited in an Annual Members' show, or won an award in an AWI show.
- **SIZE LIMITATIONS:** Hanging/2-D pieces are limited to 25 lbs. and can be no larger than 36" X 36" max. - including frame; 3-D work must fit on 12" square pedestal (11" deep X 18" shelf), & a few limited larger pieces with their own bases.
- **ONE ENTRY PER MEMBER:** Entry fee is \$25.

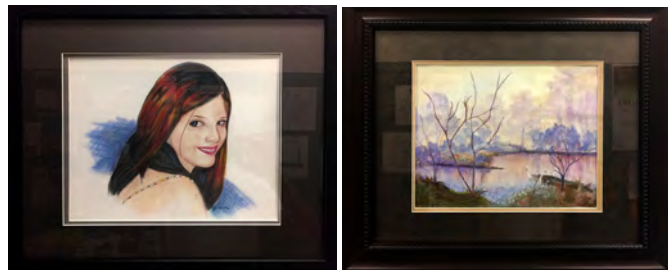
The Edgewater Library has the beautiful work of Paula McKenna on display. She has abstract art as well as realism and uses a variety of mediums. Her work will be there until late September.
