Opening January 19, 2019 **Held at AWI Studios**

- AWI DUES PAID: IMPORTANT **DEADLINE!** Member must be in good standing by Oct. 19, 2018 to be eligible to enter a work in the show.
- ORIGINAL WORK: Must be your own original work.
- **CURRENT WORK:** Work entered must be no more than 2 yrs. old, not previously exhibited in an Annual Members' show, or won an award in an AWI show.
- **SIZE LIMITATIONS:** Hanging/2-D pieces are limited to 25 lbs. and can be no larger than 36" X 36" max. - including frame; 3-D work must fit on 12" square pedestal (11" deep X 18" shelf), & a few limited larger pieces with their own bases.
- ONE ENTRY PER MEMBER: Entry fee is \$25.


