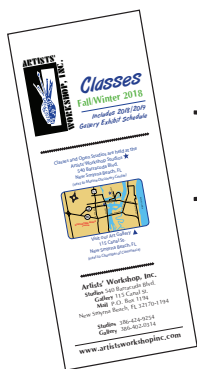

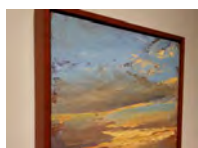

Also, due to popular demand, we are bringing back teacher Ken Nusbaum to do "Gyotaku or Fish Rubbing" with us! This one-day class will be held Tuesday, December 11, 2018, from 9:30 AM to 12:30 PM at the Artists' Workshop Studio B. Cost: is \$40.00. Call or email Margaret Anglin to register: 407.252.5726 or manglin44@gmail.com. Have fun learning about fish and creating art with them. Fish Rubbing, Gyotaku (Japanese) or U-Toh (Mandarin) is a technique developed by Japanese scientists to record their catches. Using the varied textures of rice paper and block printing ink, we will bring out the hidden features of local fishes. The work offers a Zen-like involvement with a single fish and provides unique images that are both natural, and some say, fossil-like. Ken Nusbaum is a biology professor, a member of the Marine Discovery Center Board of Directors and lots of fun.

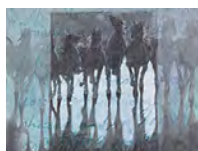

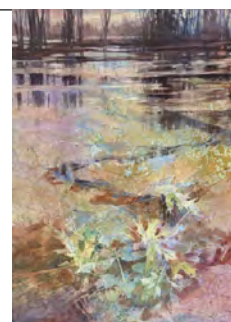

"Passport to Paris"

61st Annual Members' Juried Show Rules & Info (Hope you are all working on your masterpieces!)

On January 19th, 2019, AWI presents the Juried Annual Members Show opening Gala with a cocktail reception to be held in our Studio Gallery, 540 Barracuda Blvd, NSB. Awards will be presented and commentary from our Judge, Dr. James Murphy during the Gala. The Prospectus with labels, and important information will be made available to eligible members on our website this year. You can print your copy from the site. Copies will also be available at General Meetings, the studio workshop, and the Canal St. Gallery as well. Notice will be published in the newsletter and on the website when the Prospectus becomes available in December.

Show Entry Date and Information: January 14, Monday, 9am until Noon is intake for this show. Judging will follow at 2 pm sharp. All artwork must be on-site at noon at the latest to enable us to prepare for the juror. No late entries will be accepted. **Entry fee for the Annual Members Show is \$25.**

- One piece of artwork per person may be entered.
- Water media requiring covering must use plexiglass, or clear acrylic.
- Pastel work may use glass.
- Proper framing in good condition and strong braided wire, securely attached approximately one third down from the top of frame allowing artwork to hang close to the wall, is required.
- No fishing line, plastic or other materials will be accepted.
- No sawtooth hangers as they do not work with our hanging system.
- Works weighing more than 25 lbs cannot be hung.
- Mats must be white, off-white gray or black only.
- Simplicity in framing is critical when judging. Please keep this in mind.
- Size limitations apply. 2-D work may not exceed 36 inches in any direction including frame.
- 3-D work must fit on a pedestal no wider than 12 inches with a few exceptions determined by the chairman. The new display cabinet allows for more variety in 3-D pieces with weight and size restrictions. Please consult the Chairman.
- Smaller works are encouraged to allow as many members as our space allows to be a part of this show. Miniature paintings are encouraged.
- No theme required and choice your preferred medium and style.

Eligibility: AWI dues must have been paid and recorded by October 19, 2018, (3 months prior to date of Show to be eligible to enter). In order to maintain the professionalism, as in the past, and to limit the number of entries to fit the space allowed, this show is Juried.

Only Original artwork in oil, acrylic, watercolor, pastel, drawing, mixed media, fiber art, photography, or sculpture will be accepted that meet with the

requirements outlined above along with the following rules. Artwork must be of the artists own concept and design. Artwork that has been previously shown in an Annual Members Show, has won an award in an AWI Judged Show, or is over 2 years old will not be accepted. We rely on Members integrity to enter work that is independent of instruction by a teacher. Artwork found to be copied from other artists work will forfeit any awards. We reserve the right to remove any entry not in compliance with eligibility rules. No refund will be issued. "Waiver of Liability" forms must be completed upon entry of artwork. We handle your artwork with great deal of care but cannot be held accountable for loss or damage. Be sure to insure your own work. AWI may use images of exhibited works on our website, and in publicity materials giving credit to the artists.

Awards: Presentation of awards will take place at the show opening January 19, 2019, during the Gala. More information on the evenings lineups will be published at a date closer to the event. Dressing for the occasion is encouraged: Think bistros, street artists, cafes. Let's have fun!

To keep the show looking it's best we ask that all the Artwork remain on display until the date the show ends on Friday, February 22.

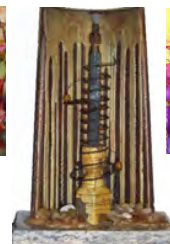

Community Exhibits

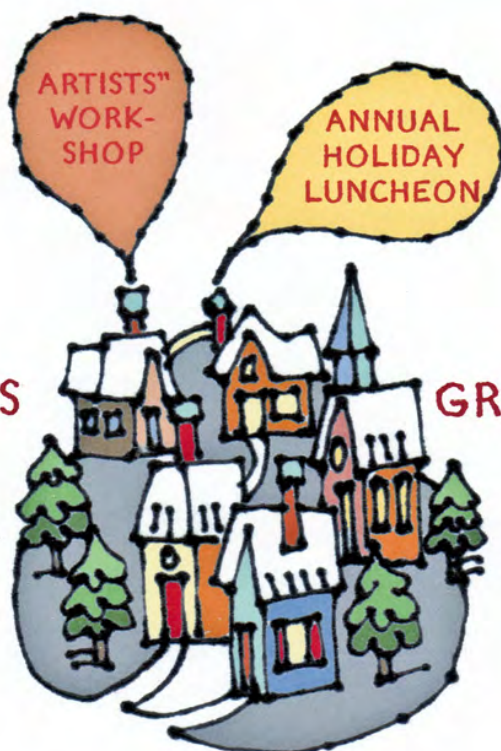

From the President

Cheryl Faber

There is so much going on within our studios, galleries and membership, that it is impossible for me to focus on only one thing in my letter.
