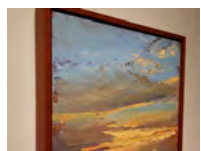

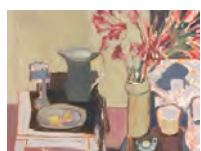

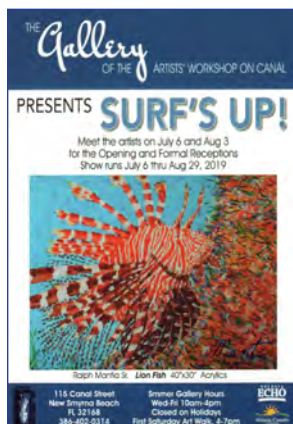

1. Paintings need to be properly wired.
2. Your name and title of the painting needs to be on the back of the painting.
3. Label information sent to me includes:

Title, Medium, Size including frame, Price, Your name

Be thinking ahead to our first themed show which will be during October and November. The title of this show is "Postcards From Florida." Paintings need to depict something typically seen in our state. Think: Florida landscapes and landmarks, flowers, palm trees, historic orange groves, birds and other animals like sea turtles, alligators, black bears, the beach. In other words...no mountains or snow scenes!

I already have a few people that have requested a panel for this show. Panels are \$25 and are first come, first serve. So if you are interested in a panel on which you can hang several paintings, let me know soon. But remember, if you want to be one of these featured artists, your artwork must go with the theme.

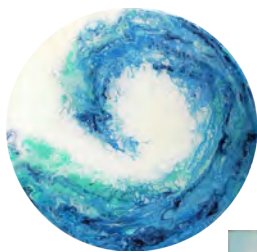
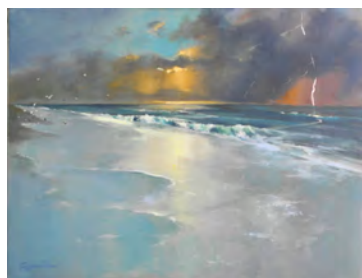
