(Pick up for the current "Postcards from Florida" show is Tues., Nov. 26 from 10 A.M. -4 P.M.) All artwork must follow published Gallery exhibits rules. Artwork must be no more than 2 years old

and must be original. No piece can be entered if it has previously won an award in any Artists' Workshop judged exhibit. Rules about gallery exhibiting apply to this show including submission of label information to the gallery chairman (now thru Tues., Nov. 26) and signing up to be a host in the gallery. NOTE: For this show you may enter work that is not for sale. Please secure a card with your ID information on the back. (See entry details on page 4.)

The Judge for this year's show is Pam Coffman, Curator of Education at the Museum of Art - DeLand. Awards for this show will be presented at the Artists' Workshop annual Holiday Luncheon to be held this year at the Brannon Center in New Smyrna Beach, on Wednesday, December 11, 2019, 11:30 A.M. Tickets for the luncheon are \$25/person and include a full buffet provided by Riverside Catering. (Details for purchasing Holiday Luncheon tickets will be forthcoming as the date draws nearer.) 
