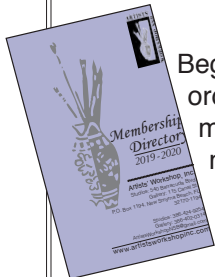

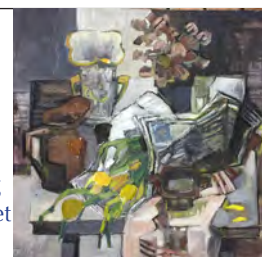


Maggie Shepherd: Feb. 15-16, 2020

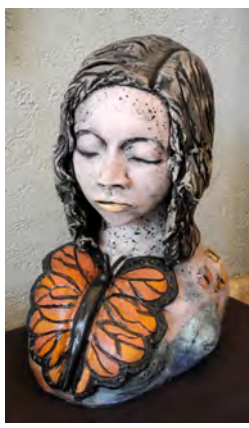

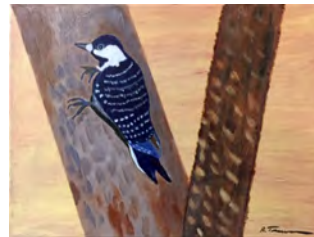
