In just a short month away on March 7, The Artists' Workshop Inc. will host its 62nd Annual Members' Show, "An Evening Under the Stars" at 540 Barracuda Blvd, New Smyrna Beach. As members of the Artists' Workshop, Inc., it's a great opportunity to challenge yourself and submit an artpiece that you have been working on.

The gala event will begin at 5pm, outdoors, where we will have catered hors d'oeuvres; wine, beer and champagne for purchase; and live music by Damian Bonazzoli, director of The Elite Academy of Music and Motion in Ormond Beach. During this time you will have the opportunity to view the beautiful artwork submitted for the show and members will be able to write down their choice for the winner of the People's Choice Award. The awards ceremony will then follow, with Dr. Gisela Carbonell, curator of Rollins College's Cornell Fine Arts Museum, as our judge.

This year there will be over \$5,000 in awards given, and the size limit for artwork submission has been increased to 40" x 40", including frame. Please refer to the show Prospectus for further information, rules and guidelines for show admission. (The Prospectus is available online, at the studios on Barracuda Blvd., or the gallery on Canal St.) **The deadline for registering for the show is Friday, February 28.** You may pay the show entry fee or event fee online, register online or register by emailing your name, email address, telephone number, name of your art piece, medium, size and price of your artwork, if for sale, to me at anamitchell2020@gmail.com. You may also pay the show entry fee when dropping off your piece of artwork on Saturday, February 29. (NOTE: If you are not entering the show and plan to just attend the Gala, you can pay your event fee at the door.)

LAGOONACY ART SHOW APRIL 18, 2020: This announcement is for AWI members inviting them to enter their work with the following theme featuring local Florida lagoon species and land species. Other works can include people of various ages interacting with the environment in healthy and conscientious ways. This can include statement pieces regarding plastics effects on our coastal water and sea life, invasive species such as the Lion Fish, and beach cleanup. Plein Air works are encouraged. Abstracts are welcomed. Mixed medium could include plastic. Small watercolors of starfish, seahorses, etc., Small easel-backed frames can have glass due to their small size. They can sit on our shelves or pedestals.

STYLES / MEDIUMS ACCEPTED: All styles & all mediums on canvas and panels, clay sculpture, other sculpture, and photography are accepted. Suitable framing, wired to hang properly, easel-backed small frames, glass is accepted on pastel work. Please use Plexiglas and vinyl covering for other works on sizes larger than 11x14, such as watercolor and some collage if needed. Giclee and framed prints are acceptable for this show. We encourage students to create their own artwork. Class work is welcome!! A portion of the Art sales on April 18th will be donated to the Marine Discovery Center for their annual fundraiser.
