If you haven't seen the show yet, it will be hanging for the month of March, so take some time and drop by and see what over one hundred of your fellow members have created....what a talented bunch!

If you attended the Gala or have been by the studios since then, you may have noticed our growing "shed village" located on the Pavilion to the north side of studio A, and wondered why they are all there. Marine Discovery Center is responsible for three of those sheds which were moved there after they had been vandalized and had over \$3000 worth of equipment stolen. At the same time, we were in the process of purchasing another larger shed to house two new kilns and other equipment that had been donated to AWI, so we decided to locate them all together. A very attractive white fence and better lighting will be installed in order to make the whole area more secure. On a brighter note, MDC set up a "GO FUND ME" page to raise the funds needed to replace the stolen equipment, and within three days had surpassed the amount they were trying to raise! So maybe every dark cloud does have a silver lining!

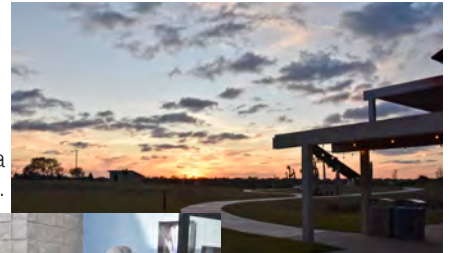

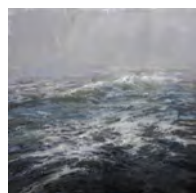

18, 2020: This announcement is for AWI members inviting them to enter their work within the following theme featuring local Florida lagoon species and land species. Other works can include people of various ages interacting with the environment in healthy and conscientious ways. This can include statement pieces regarding plastics effects on our coastal water and sea life, invasive species such as the Lion Fish, and beach cleanup. Plein Air works are encouraged. Abstracts are welcomed. Mixed medium could include plastic. Small watercolors of starfish, seahorses, etc., in small easel-backed frames can have glass due to their small size. They can sit on our shelves or pedestals.

STYLES / MEDIUMS ACCEPTED: All styles and all mediums on canvas and panels, clay sculpture, other sculpture, and photography are accepted. Suitable framing, wired to hang properly, easel-backed small frames, glass is accepted on pastel work. Please use Plexiglas and vinyl covering for other works on sizes larger than 11x14, such as watercolor and some collage if needed. Giclee and framed prints are acceptable for this show. We encourage students to create their own artwork. Class work is welcome!! Small, simple artwork pieces sell well for this show.

Cards or unframed prints of your artwork can be sold on the day of the event. Prints must be in a print rack to be shown. Prints in racks and cards of artwork must be taken home at the end of the day on April 18th as we have no place to show them for sale in our studio.

A percentage of the sales donation on April 18th will be donated to the Marine Discovery Center for their annual fundraiser.

Sales after April 18th - sales percentage donation goes to AWI.
