We are working hard to get a new and exciting schedule together for the fall when we can hopefully meet again in a creative environment. We are implementing the CDC guidelines for our current classes so everybody is safe. We have a limited summer schedule with new classes being added as they become available. Otherwise we should be able to resume classes as usual beginning August/September.

Clay class preliminary fall schedule: Hand building class with Yolanda on Monday afternoons; Richard will start up wheel classes on Tuesday & Friday mornings; Hand building class with Susie on Wednesday mornings; Susie also plans to teach an Ornament class the 4 weeks leading up to Christmas.

The matting and framing room remains closed during the summer.

The Gallery on Canal St.

Since the Chamber of Commerce has opened again, we are now able to open our Gallery on Canal as well. These are my immediate plans for the gallery. Of course it depends on what happens with COVID-19 in Florida in the near future.

I will open the gallery on First Saturday in July from 4 - 7 PM. This happens to be July 4th. We will not serve food and drinks and due to our small space will limit the number of guests in the gallery at any one time to three. The show that we put up right before we had to close will remain throughout July. Our hours during the week will be Tuesdays and Thursdays from 11 a.m. to 2 p.m. The Chamber is closing earlier during this time. I will be calling on volunteers to sit, and am asking that they wear a mask when visitors come in.

In August we are going to have a special show of plein air paintings that have been done during this time. It will feature Cathy Berse and Barbara Ortiz who did a painting a day and together painted 65 paintings! The title of this show is "Daily Plein Air Inspirations... Help the Paintout" 50% of sales will be divided between Artists' Workshop and Marine Discovery Center to supplement the Paint Out this fall. We will have extra advertising for this show. If you are interested in joining this fundraiser show, please send me your label information now so I can gauge how much room I will have for additional paintings. During August we will be open on Wed., Thurs., and Friday and if the Chamber goes back to regular hours we go back to being open from 10 a.m. - 4 p.m.

September will be an Artists' Choice show.

October/November will be the "Black and White With a Splash of Color" show that was already planned and will have featured artists. Panels have already been reserved. December will be our small works judged show.

If you want a sneak peek into next year...I would like to have a "Big and Beautiful" show for you artists that JUST HAVE TO PAINT BIG! There will be a minimum size requirement. And after getting a great suggestion from Bob Stinziano, we will have a themed show called "For the Birds." Paintings will need to have a bird in it somewhere. And at some time next year I still want to have the Celebrating America show.

Be watching constant contact for all information about drop off and pick up dates for these shows. And since a few people picked up their paintings from the show that is in the gallery now, I can add a few more to this "Artists' Choice" Show. In Memoriam

Ella Lawless

he Artists' Workshop mourns the loss of Ella Lawless, a longtime member and watercolor teacher (age 87). Ella, passed away peacefully on May 31, 2020 in Ormond Beach, FL. Ella started her teaching career with the Artists' Workshop when our classroom was on the second floor of the Chamber building. Always enthusiastic and energetic, Ella had a unique way of critiquing students artwork, by putting everyone's work on the floor (along with her) and sitting there until everybody had been critiqued.

Born in East Moriches, NY in 1932, Ella attended and graduated from East Moriches schools and continued her education to become a licensed cosmetologist in New York, NY. She married Matthew Lawless in 1951 and they moved to Riverhead, NY and raised 8 children. In 1980, Ella and Matt moved to Florida, first to Brooksville then Deland, finally settling in New Smyrna Beach. Sadly, Matt passed away on 7/31/2001, only months before their 50th wedding anniversary. As a woman ahead of her time, Ella began her career as a hair stylist in Jamesport, NY and continued to find new successes for her creativity in interior decorating and fashion design. Later



in life, her artistic talents blossomed as she fell in love with watercolor painting, becoming a multi-award winning artist and beloved teacher, active in the New Smyrna Beach arts community. Ella is survived by her 8 children and 15 grandchildren.


