
10th Anniversary **NSB Plein Air Paint Out**



- **ELIGIBLITY/FEE:** The entry fee for the Annual Members' Show is \$30, we are not charging admission to the show this year. AWI dues must have been paid by **December 6, 2020**, three months prior to the date of the Members' Show to enter. Due to the limited space of our Studio Gallery, if we receive more than 95 (ninety-five) entries for the show, the show will become a juried show and selected by our judge. Entry fees will not be returned to works removed from juried show.
- ARTWORK: One piece of artwork per person is allowed. No theme, your choice of medium and your style. No 2-D artwork can exceed 40" in any direction including the frame. 3-D artwork must fit on a pedestal and be no wider than 18". Artwork must be of the artist's own concept and design. Work weighing more than 25 lbs. cannot be hung with our setup and will not be accepted. Artwork that has been previously shown in an annual members' show, has won an award in an AWI judged show, or is over 2 years old will not be accepted. Additional details will be posted on our website and in the prospectus as the date draws near.





"The Mistress of Paris: The 19th-Century Courtesan Who Built an Empire on a Secret" by Catherine Hewitt and Jane Barker



Comtesse Valtesse de la Bigne was painted by Édouard Manet and inspired Émile Zola, who immortalized her in his scandalous novel Nana. Her rumored affairs with Napoleon III and the future King Edward VII kept gossip columns full.
