Dear Members,

Please vote "YES" for Volusia ECHO and "YES" for Volusia Forever on November 3. The funding for these two programs ends next year. We need to vote "YES" for these amendments so that Volusia County will continue to have funding available to build and restore cultural, historic and recreational facilities, as well as to protect our water quality and environmentally sensitive lands. Voting "YES" will not increase your taxes. If we renew these amendments now, the tax rate will remain the same as it has been for the past twenty years. On a personal note, Artists' Workshop would not be housed in our studios today had it not been for an ECHO grant. SO, Please vote "YES"!

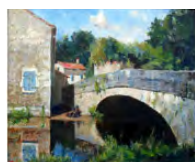
Fall Classes Update

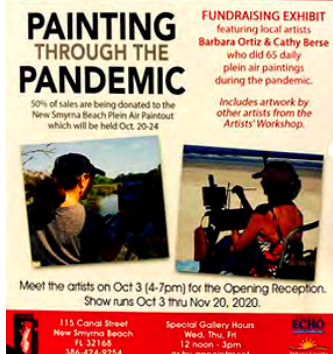

ELIGIBILITY/FEE: The entry fee for the Annual Members' Show is \$30, we are not charging admission to the show this year. AWI dues must have been paid by **December 6, 2020**.

ARTWORK: One piece of artwork per person is allowed. No theme, your choice of medium and your style. **No 2-D artwork can exceed 40" in any direction including the frame. 3-D artwork must fit on a pedestal and be no wider than 18".** Work weighing more than 25 lbs. cannot be hung with our setup and will not be accepted.

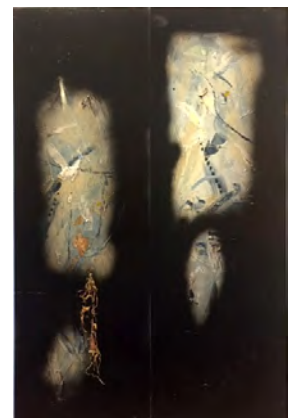
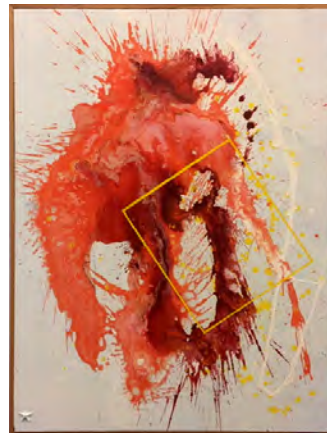
