

With the New Year comes predictions for surging cases of Covid this winter. In an effort to keep our members safe and still keep our doors open for classes, workshops and shows, the Board of Directors has voted to tighten up the guidelines to follow when you are using the studios or are at the gallery. They are as follows:



JUDGE DAVID FITHIAN

I grew up in Daytona Beach, Florida as a creative child surrounded by creative individuals who supported my interest in art. In 1967 I attended the Art Students League in Woodstock, New York, and then went to the Pennsylvania Academy of the Fine Arts from 1968 to 1972. As a Philadelphia artist I worked in various galleries and managed the Graphics Department at Drexel University from 1974 to 1980. My first one person show was held at the legendary Painted Bride Gallery in 1975. From 1975 to 1980 I collaborated with many other artists working in various disciplines including performance art.

In the 1980's I lived in Orlando, Florida where I taught at the Crealde School of Art in Winter Park, Florida and conducted a watercolor class at the Maitland Art Center in Maitland, Florida from 1984 until 1990. In 1991 I moved to Eureka Springs, Arkansas and was a special feature writer/ photographer for the local newspaper while painting, drawing and operating a commercial photography studio.

In 2000 I returned to Florida and opened a fine art gallery for a short time before becoming Curator of Art and Exhibitions at the Museum of Art – DeLand, Florida for the next 19 years. I have always had an active painting studio throughout my diverse career and exhibited regularly.

Presently I maintain a working studio and Micro Gallery in DeLand, FL. I am also currently an independent curator for the Museum of Art – DeLand for specific exhibitions. Over the last 15 years I have had the pleasure and privilege of being invited to judge and co-judge many regional exhibitions.

ANNUAL MEMBERS' SHOW RULES

ENTRY

On March 6th, 2021, AWI presents the 63rd Annual Members' Show at the Studio Gallery. This is Champagne and Desserts gallery viewing from 6-7 p.m. followed by the awards presentation promptly at 7:30 p.m.

The entry fee for the Annual Members' Show is \$30 (includes you and a guest at our reception), additional guest will be \$10. Checks are payable to: Artists' Workshop, Inc. or register and pay on line at www.artistsworkshopnsb.com, starting February 1st. ART CHECK-IN WILL BE FRIDAY FEB 26TH STARTING AT 1:30 P.M. AT THE ARTISTS' WORKSHOP ON 540 BARRACUDA BLVD. NSB. Please bring your entry with completed labels attached to the back of your 2-D pieces. The 3-D pieces must be accompanied with completed labels to be placed beneath or alongside the entry. Your signed Prospectus and signed "Waiver of Liability" are required for entry. NO LATE ENTRIES.

One piece of artwork per person is allowed. Water media requiring covering must use Plexiglas or Acrylic. Pastel work may use glass. Proper framing requires using strong braided wire that is securely attached on the back approximately one third down from the frame top. This enables the artwork to lay flatly against the wall. No sawtooth hangers, fishing line, plastic or other materials will be accepted. Wrapped canvases must have painted edges, if not framed. Multiples must be displayed with one hanger, (meaning all panels must be firmly connected within the 40" size limit).

Mats must be white (preferred), off-white, gray or black. Simplicity in framing is critical when judging. Size limitations apply. Work weighing more than 25 lbs.' cannot be hung with our setup and will not be accepted. **No 2-D artwork can exceed 40" in any direction including the frame. 3-D artwork must fit on a pedestal and be no wider than 18"**, with a few exceptions determined by the Members show chairman. Clay pieces require felt pads to protect the glass or wood surfaces for display. Smaller works are encouraged to enable as many members to participate in the show as space allows. **Multiples of 3-D artwork must be connected on a base within the 18" size limit.**

ELIGIBILITY

- 1. AWI dues must have been paid by December 6, 2020, three months prior to the date of the Members' Show to enter. Article X, Exhibition Rules, Section 1, of the Artists' Workshop Inc. Bylaws.
- 2. No theme, your choice of medium and your style. Only original artwork in oil, acrylic, watercolor, pastel, drawing, mixed media, photography or sculpture and Digital media will be accepted that meet the above requirements and the following rules. Artwork must be of the artist's own concept and design.
- 3. Artwork that has been previously shown in an Annual Members' Show, has won an award in an AWI judged show, or is over two years old will not be accepted. We rely on members' integrity to enter work that is independent of instruction by a teacher, workshop or online class instruction.
- 4. Artwork found to be copied from other artists' work will forfeit any awards.
- 5. We reserve the right to remove any entry not in compliance with eligibility rules. No refund will be issued.
- **6.** "Waiver of Liability" forms must be completed upon entry of artwork. We handle all artwork with a great deal of care but cannot be accountable for loss or damage. You may insure your artwork. AWI may use images of exhibited artwork on our website and/or in publicity materials giving credit to the artists.
- 7. Due to the limited space of our Studio Gallery, if we receive more than "95" ninety-five entries for the show, the show will become a juried show and selected by our judge. Entry fees will not be returned to works removed from juried show.

Frances Crawford Fixaris



he Artists' Workshop mourns the loss of former AWI President (1994-1996) and longtime member Frances Crawford Fixaris (89) who passed away on Friday, December 18, 2020 in New Smyrna. Our deepest sympathies go out to all her family and friends.

Frances Crawford Fixaris was born October 19, 1931 in Sunbury, Pennsylvania. She grew up living with her parents, brother and sister in Sunbury and then Berwick, Pennsylvania before going to Susquehanna University. She graduated from Susquehanna receiving her bachelor's degree in music performance and education. Fran taught music in Pennsylvania, Missouri, New York, New Jersey, and Florida. She also had a career in broadcasting working at station WVII or channel 7 in Bangor, Maine, even having her own

show called Fran's World. Fran sang in many places including in New York City for Leonard Bernstein and in Miami for the Opera Guild of Greater Miami. Later in life Fran became a watercolor artist working with the Artist's Workshop in New Smyrna Beach. She particularly liked to see the colors in the world around her and she liked to play the Bach suites on her piano. Fran loved her music, her dog, her friends, the beach, and living in New Smyrna Beach. Frances was predeceased by her parents Homer and Frances Drumm, her two husbands, and her brother and sister.
