High School Art Scholarships

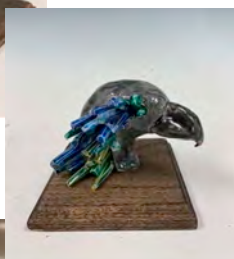

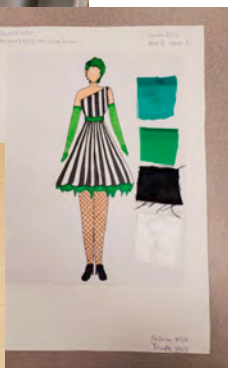

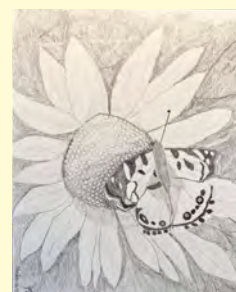
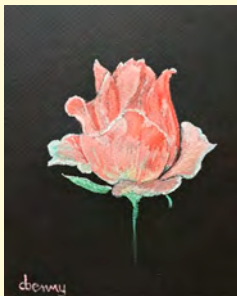
Spring Artists' Workshop Art Challenge - Wrap Up

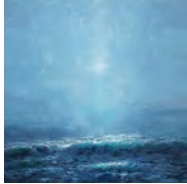

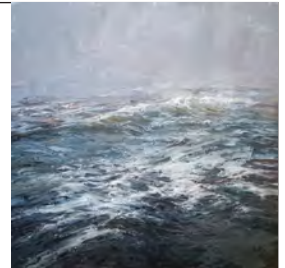
"Palette Knife Painting - The Sea" (oil/acrylic)

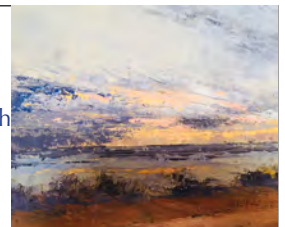
Trish Vevera: November 13-14, 2021

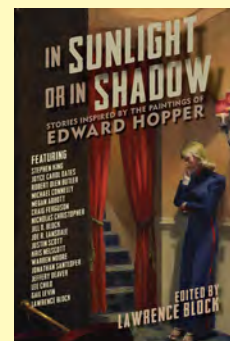
