

he pick up and delivery dates for our small works judged show, "Deck the Walls," HAVE BEEN CHANGED due to the fact that I will be out of town from Dec. 1 through Dec. 6. Please make note of the new pick up and delivery dates: either MONDAY, NOV. 29th FROM 11AM-2 P.M., OR TUESDAY, NOV. 30th FROM 9-11 A.M. Your paintings will be up for the First Sat. Gallery Stroll in December but will not be judged until Dec. 7th. Awards will be presented at the Holiday luncheon on Dec. 8th.

#### Here are the details about the small works judged show:

- 1. Entry fee is \$20.00. This pays for the judge, ribbons and prize money. The amount of prize money I am able to give depends on the number of entries.
- 2. Work can be no more than two years old and cannot have been entered in a previously judged show. Paintings must be your own work and cannot be copied from published sources such as magazines or the internet.
- 3. Image size is no more than 8"x 10". (This is a change from last year.) I am not concerned about the frame size.
- 4. There is no theme for this show. Don't let the title fool you into thinking it's a Christmas/Holiday theme!
- 5. Please begin sending your label information for this judged show NOW to <a href="mailto:gramclayton@gmail.com">gramclayton@gmail.com</a> (Title/Medium/Size/Price (or NFS)/ Your Name).

Congratulations to Pam Sawyer on the sale of three paintings out of the current "Something Yellow" show as well as Valeh Levy, Sallee Langley and Gale Saunders for each selling one of their paintings.

Starting in December, we will go back to being open from 10am-4pm on Tuesday through Friday. Sitters can choose to sit from 10am-1pm or 1pm-4pm. Hours stay the same on Saturdays.

Be thinking ahead to the Jan./Feb. show - "Big and Beautiful." There is no theme - except size - for this show and no featured artists. The entry fee is \$10 and there will be room for only one painting per person. The MINIMUM size is 36 in. in either direction and no larger than 46 in. framed. I will still hang small paintings on the wire racks at a charge of \$5.00. These fees will cover the cost of the extra advertising for this show. Space is going to be limited so send your information early! I already have one entry!

This show will run around the same time as the Canal St. Gallery's "Big and Beautiful" show, giving our artists who love to paint large many opportunities to show their work.



he Artists' Workshop mourns the loss of a dear friend, local artist, and AWI exhibit judge, Trish Thompson. Our deepest sympathies go out to all her family and friends.

Artist and educator Patricia Kelly Thompson, age 74, of New Smyrna Beach, died peacefully Monday September 27, 2021 at Halifax Health Hospice, Edgewater. More than just an artist, she was an irreplaceable, influential anchor in the community. She made people believe in who they are and what they are capable of.

Born and raised in Panama City, FL, she completed her bachelor and masters' degrees in studio art and art education & constructive design at Florida State University. She served as Curator of Education at the Museum of Arts and Sciences, Daytona Beach; and Curator of Education at the Southeast Museum of Photography at Daytona State College. She attained the rank of Professor in the Department of Cultural Arts at Daytona State College, retiring in 2013, having taught painting, design and art appreciation courses. Trish was a founding artist at Arts on Douglas of the Atlantic Center for the Arts in New Smyrna Beach, where she was selected to participate in four residencies at the ACA.

She is survived by her husband of 34 years James J. Murphy, 2 children, and 2 grandchildren. (courtesy Settle-Wilder Funeral Home and Cremation Service)
