The bridge is scheduled to be shutdown for the project to begin on May 2, 2022 and the bridge will not be completed for 20 -24 months. I just want you to be aware that this will be happening and there will be an alternate route for getting to the studios, which I am sure will be well signed. We will also try to keep you updated by emails and the newsletter. None of this work will affect our ability to stay open and continue on with our classes, workshops and special events!

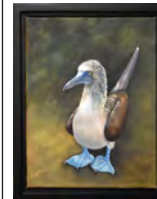

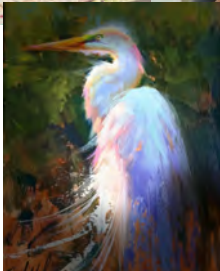

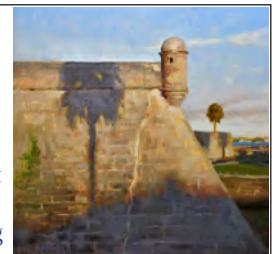
Antwan Ramar: April 4, 11, 18, and 25, 2022 "A Slow Approach to Succeed Faster"

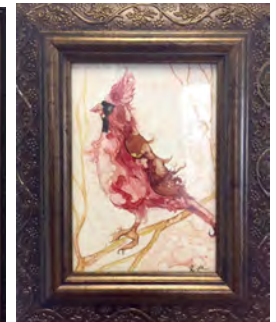
