"Sunflowers: Supporting Ukraine Through Art"

(above) The Gallery on Canal St. "Sunflowers for Ukraine" exhibit is up through June 29th. According to the UN, almost one child per second in Ukraine is becoming a refugee of war. When you purchase a sunflower painting, the artist will donate a percentage of the sale to the Artists' Workshop. All donations will then be sent to UNICEF to help the children of Ukraine. The Artists' Workshop will be taking no commissions from these sales. Donations help UNICEF ensure that Ukraine's children have access to safe water, food, health care, education and protection.

I want to thank all of our members who have generously supported the "Sunflowers" show at the Gallery on Canal St. It has been a huge success. At this point we have sold 41 pieces of art as well as numerous note cards and pendants. Donations from just the painting sales are close to \$4,000. I'm estimating that the rest of the sales as well as additional donations are adding up to another \$1,000. And we have another month for this show! Keep painting those sunflowers, because I will need replacements. The Sunflower show runs through June 29.

Don't forget to come to the First Saturday Gallery Walk on June 4 from 4-7 P.M. There are several new pieces of art to see. And if you haven't seen it already...look up as you come in. We have a new banner above the door!

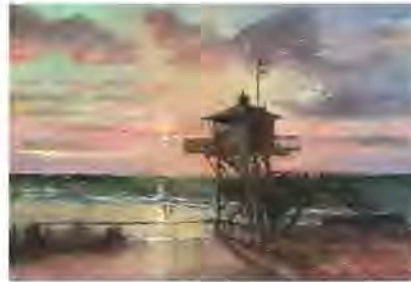

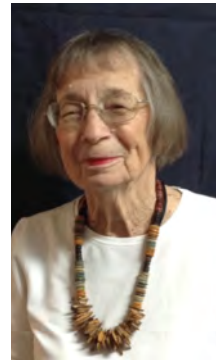

The Artists' Workshop mourns the loss of Dorothy "Dot" Richards, a longtime AWI member and dear friend to many members. Our deepest sympathies go out to all her family and friends.

Dorothy M. Richards, age 97, of New Smyrna Beach, died Thursday, April 21, 2022 at Halifax Health Hospice, Port Orange. 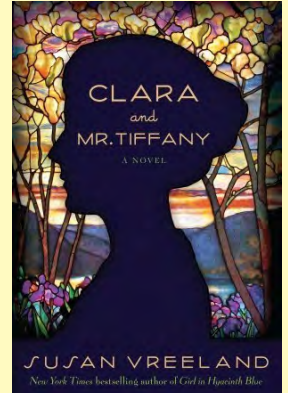
Library News:
