sent to UNICEF to help the children of Ukraine. The Artists' Workshop will be taking no commissions from these sales. Donations help UNICEF ensure that Ukraine's children have access to safe water, food, health care, education and protection.






### Coming in July/August: "FUN SUMMER CLASSES!"


