

Christine Peloquin: November 5-6, 2022 "Painting & Drawing With Mixed Media Collage" (Part 2)

Learn the joys of mixed media collage. In the workshop, teach the fundamentals of collage, drawing and painting while challenging artists to unlock and find their inner voice. I have techniques for both beginners and advanced artists who want to enhance their skill sets. I will address working with papers, fabrics, found objects, past artwork



pencil and charcoal drawing, and acrylic painting. Students have the option to play with gelli plates, stamps and monoprinting on papers in addition the collage. The materials used will be the choice of each student, but students are encouraged to incorporate some of their own prior artwork into new pieces. The objective of the workshop is to explore new mixed media techniques and excavate each student's authentic voice in their art. (Attendance at Part 1 workshop not required.)

Learn Manon's secrets about how to make a vibrant, light-filled painting by implementing techniques that will replace random decision making with intentional choices in regards to the pillars of creating a painting. Manon will demonstrate her process step-by-step in order to give you




the confidence to use your new skills on your own. Manon will dive deeply into color mixing and the use of color in easy to understand terms and will help you at your easel with your own painting. Although you will paint a still life in this class, you can use the learned techniques to all subject matter. Oil preferred, acrylics acceptable. 
