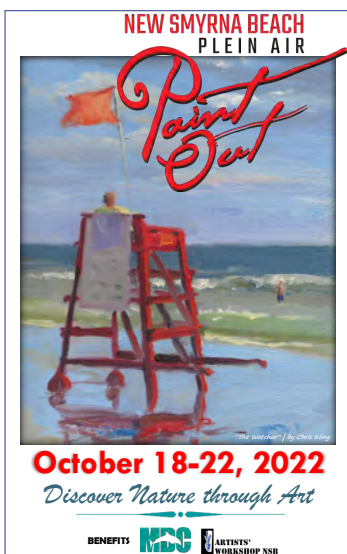

Christine Peloquin: November 5-6, 2022 "Painting & Drawing With Mixed Media Collage" (Part 2)

Learn the joys of mixed media collage. In the workshop, I will teach the fundamentals of collage, drawing and painting while challenging artists to unlock and find their inner voice. I have techniques for both beginners and advanced artists who want to enhance their skill sets. I will address working with papers, fabrics, found objects, past artwork, pencil and charcoal drawing, and acrylic painting. Students have the option to play with gelli plates, stamps and monoprinting on papers in addition to the collage. The materials used will be the choice of each student, but students are encouraged to incorporate some of their own prior artwork into new pieces. The objective of the workshop is to explore new mixed media techniques and excavate each student's authentic voice in their art. (Attendance at Part 1 workshop not required.)

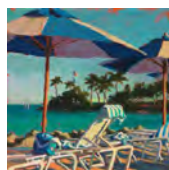

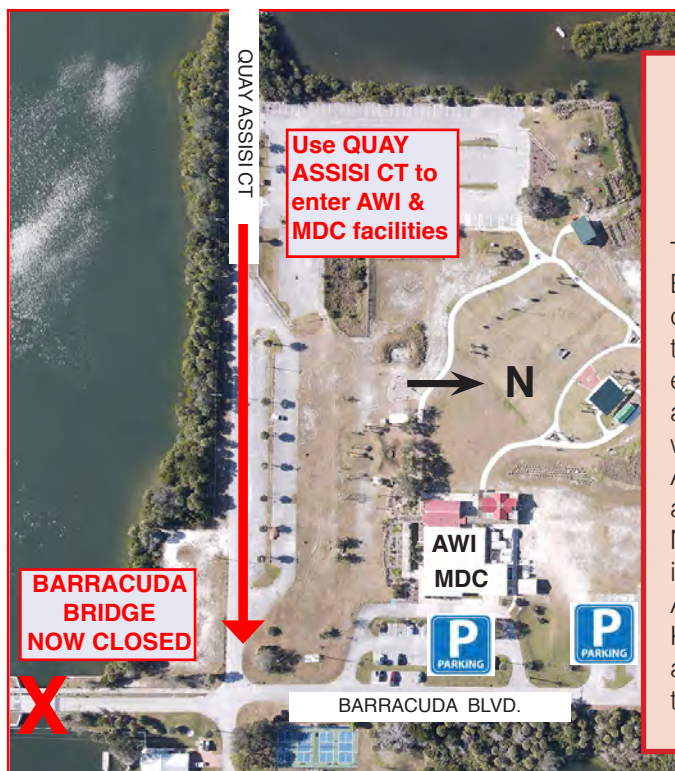
Manon Sander: November 14, 2022 "Simplifying the Landscape" (en Plein Air)

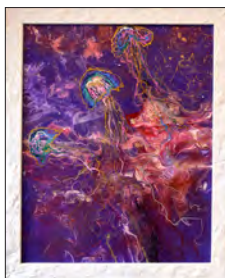
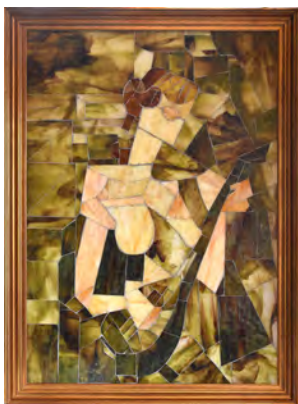

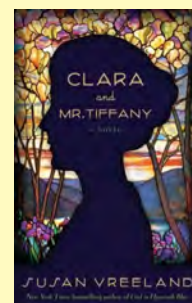
