In Memoriam

Harold Garde (1923-2022)

he Artists' Workshop mourns the loss of renowned artist, teacher, mentor, and AWI special friend, Harold Garde. Our deepest sympathies go out to all his family and friends.

Artist Harold Garde, age 99, an influential Abstract Expressionist painter died Monday October 11, 2022 in Florida. He was the originator of the Strappo technique that combined painting and printmaking. Born in New York City to Eastern European Jewish immigrants, Harold served in the U.S. Air Force from 1943-45 during World War II. He went to art school at the University of Wyoming on the GI Bill. Garde returned to New York to complete his master's degree at Columbia and then entered the city's burgeoning arts scene alongside artists like Andy Warhol, Jackson Pollock and Mark Rothko. He and his first wife had four children, and he worked

as an interior designer and later as a teacher to support them. He still painted and absorbed himself in the culture, if only on a part-time basis.

Artist Harold Garde had technically retired when he moved to Maine in 1983, but in many ways his career was just starting. He experienced arguably his most productive period in the '80s and '90s from his waterfront studio in Belfast, ME where he painted bold and provocative abstract pieces. His paintings are part of the permanent collections at several museums around the country, including at the Metropolitan Museum of Art in New York.




